District Councillor Report

- HDC accounts and reserves discussed. £5.5 million has been put into reserves
 this year total put into reserves since 2022 £14 million, giving DC total of £170
 million of which £96 million is usable (rest is ring fenced) so DC has plenty of
 cash. However, big cuts over next 5 years and 5% council tax rise.
 - N.B. No plan on how to use usable reserve before local government reorganization – see below. Important that it should be used for Huntingdon not go into unitary pot.

- Note the audited accounts released and in public domain but not really comprehensible to public
- Large CIL reserve CIL round just started.
- Local government reorganisation 3 options for creating unitary body (below is taken from HDC website:

Proposal A - A North-West/South-East Option

- Unitary 1: Peterborough City Council, Huntingdonshire and Fenland District Councils - along with County Council functions.
- Unitary 2: Cambridge City Council, East Cambridgeshire and South Cambridgeshire District Councils - along with County Council functions.

Proposal B - A North/South Option

- Unitary 1: Peterborough City Council, East Cambridgeshire, Fenland and Huntingdonshire District Councils - along with County Council functions.
- Unitary 2: Cambridge City Council and South Cambridgeshire District along with County Council functions.

Proposal C - An East/West Option

- Unitary 1: Peterborough City Council, East Cambridgeshire and Fenland District Councils - along with County Council functions.
- Unitary 2: Cambridge City Council, Huntingdonshire and South Cambridgeshire District Councils - along with County Council functions.

Note: Parish Councils will not be affected.

Timeline:

2025/6 Councils put forward proposals – then evaluated

2027 Elections to unitary authority

2028 New unitary authority takes over

(Doesn't look like these deadlines will be met but DC's will keep us informed)

- Cycle path. Ideas to get some funding towards badly needed cycle path. Unitary authorities will be responsible for travel infrastructure – CIL when A141 developed.
